In Tennessee, whenever there is a valid lease or a landlord has accepted payment for rent, Tennessee law (Tenn. Code Ann. Title 66, Ch. 28) establishes a landlord-tenant relationship and both parties have special rights and duties. Tenants have the right to a habitable living space and the right to pursue at least one form of alternative action, among others.

As of 2019, Philadelphia law requires landlords to always give tenants 30 days' notice for one of several specified "good causes."
